



Bin 407 Cabernet Sauvignon 1994

Penfolds Bin 407 Cabernet Sauvignon was introduced in 1993 with the 1990 vintage. As increasing quantities of high quality Cabernet Sauvignon became available, Penfolds seized the opportunity to create a wine in the mould of Bin 707, but in greater quantities and at a more affordable price.

The 1994 Bin 407 shows many classic Cabernet features - stylish varietal expression, structure and cellaring potential.

COLOUR

Medium deep red.

NOSE

Intense cassis, chocolate, mint, brambly aromas.

The palate is dense and chocolaty with blackcurrant, leafy flavours, abundant, loose-knit, chalky tannins and underlying oak. Finishes long and sweet.
