



Bin 2 Shiraz Mourvedre

PENFOLDS Bin 2 Shiraz Mourvedre is a well-established wine in the PENFOLDS range, with the first vintage produced in 1960. It is a uniquely Australian wine made predominantly from Shiraz, which usually accounts for about 70 percent of the blend.

PENFOLDS Bin 2 is a soft, inviting wine with the Shiraz berry-fruit flavours complemented by a penetrating, spicy edge derived from the Barossa Valley Mourvedre.

Winemaker comments by John Duval

COLOUR

Crimson in colour with purple hues.

NOSE

The fresh and youthful bouquet shows prominent, cherry-like varietal fruit and some zesty spice with a trace of underlying oak adding complexity.

PALATE

Medium bodied and full flavoured, the palate has youthful, spicy, berry fruit characters with the Mourvedre component quite pronounced at the time of release. The wine shows an excellent balance of weight and fruit, a full, soft mid-palate and a long fin
