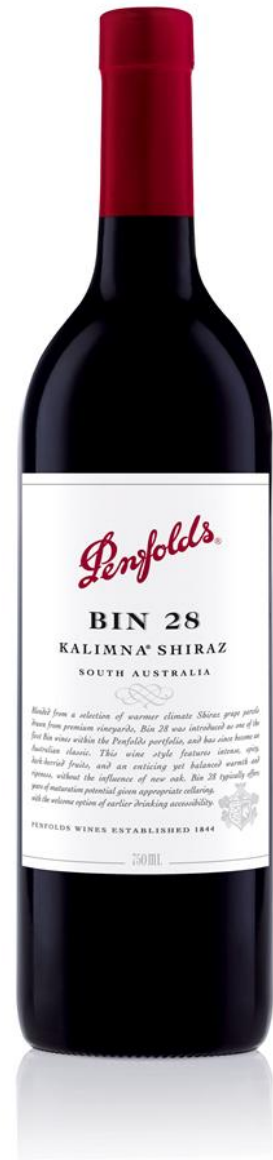




Bin 28 Kalimna Shiraz

1987

A classic Australian Shiraz, named after Penfolds' Kalimna Vineyard in the Barossa Valley. It is a wine known internationally for its consistent high quality value for money and cellaring potential. Premium Shiraz grapes from the low yielding Kalimna Vineyard are selected, as well as Shiraz from other renowned South Australian wine districts to provide the full spectrum of varietal aromas and flavours, thereby adding complexity to the wine.

COLOUR

Medium red.

NOSE

Fresh earthy, mocha, mushroom, leafy, herb garden aromas.

PALATE

The palate is restrained with sweet earthy, dried cherry, herbal flavours and leafy, sinewy tannins. Fruit fades towards the finish leaving a dry tannin slick. Cool-vintage wine. Will hold but drink soon.
