Koonunga Hill takes its name from the Koonunga Hill Vineyard in the Barossa Valley. The first vintage was in 1976. since that time koonunga Hill has steadily built a reputation world-wide as one of Australia's best value-for-money red wines. This is understandable given the wine's remarkable consistency, quality and ageing potential. The wine is matured in American and French oak barrels which contributes a level of complexity not normally found in reds in its price range.



VINEYARD REGION	South Australia
VINTAGE CONDITIONS	The spring and summer preceding the 1994 vintage were cool and dry in most parts of Australia. The result was a very late vintage. A long mild autumn allowed full ripeness to be achieved in most areas.

MATURATION	Matured in American and French oak barrels for 12 months.

COLOUR

Medium crimson.

NOSE

Developed dried fruit/graphite/meaty aromas.
