

Penfolds Cellar Reserve Merlot is sourced from a single vineyard in the northern end of the Adelaide Hills region and is a unique expression of this grape variety. Mild day temperatures and cooler evenings were ideal ripening conditions and have delivered a very tightly structured Merlot, rich in colour and aroma. This enabled the creation of only the second Penfolds Cellar Reserve Merlot ever released.

Matured for a period of 16 months in seasoned French oak barrels, this wine is drinking well at release, and will continue to drink well for many years with careful cellaring.

Medium-deep colour. Very elemental with lifted spearmint, dried roses, plum, violet, black fruit aromas with a touch of graphite. Sinewy in texture, with juicy fruit, brambly, mint, herb flavours with robust tannins. Needs several years to unfold and soften.
