

## Koonunga Hill Shiraz Cabernet 1994

Koonunga Hill takes its name from the Koonunga Hill Vineyard in the Barossa Valley. The first vintage was in 1976. since that time koonunga Hill has steadily built a reputation world-wide as one of Australia's best value-for-money red wines. This is understandable given the wine's remarkable consistency, quality and ageing potential. The wine is matured in American and French oak barrels which contibutes a level of coplexity not normally found in reds in its price range.
