BIN 51 EDEN VALLEY RIESLING

2011

Created in the 1990's as part of the evolving Penfolds white wine development program, Penfolds Bin 51 Eden Valley Riesling captures the essence of the Eden Valley Riesling style. The region's high altitude and cool climate induces Riesling with great complexity and capacity for long term cellaring.

South Australia is gaining worldwide recognition for producing definitive World Class Riesling, with the Eden Valley at the very head of the field. The wines show typically focussed apple and lime aromas, with a mineral edge and marked natural acidity contributing significantly to the palate texture and flavour.

The evolution of Penfolds Bin 51 Eden Valley Riesling opens new chapters in a long history of Penfolds involvement in fine winemaking from this variety.

COLOUR

Very pale straw with lime green hues.

NOSE

Lifted aromatics of lemon/lime citrus, lemon sherbet, citrus blossom and hints of tropical fruits.

PALATE

Concentrated flavours of lime juice, citrus fruits and mouthwatering mineral acidity combine to offer impressive structure and length of flavour.

VINEYARD REGION

Eden Valley, South Australia.

VINTAGE CONDITIONS

The 2011 vintage was characterised by plentiful rains during Spring taking dam capacities near to or 100% full, however lower than average temperatures and abundant rainfall during the growing season, veraison and harvest produced a vintage that challenged both winemakers and viticulturists alike.

GRAPE VARIETY

Riesling.

MATURATION

After fermentation the wine was quickly and sensitively prepared for bottling to retain varietal purity.
