Variable conditions continued October to December, merging into a mild summer, with a few short periods of ling the Coonawarra experienced cooler temperatures for flowering ahead of ons, with lower yields contributing to an earlier start to harvest. Across each region, condition. Smaller berry and bunch sizes were noticeable in most regions. reather conditions, great results were delivered for traditional quality markers concentration and flavour depth.

impenetrable core

appear less 100% Cabernet Sauvignon, more 100% Bin 707! past all others – the formics, smoked nuts/meats. sweet soy sauces and concentrated tomato paste aromatics. lack forest cake/tiramisu and choc/coffee affogato exotics. voak? Yes, perhaps the primary source of those (repressed) nutty/toasty wafts...? . Complex, layered.
