KOONUNGA HILL SEVENTY-SIX SHIRAZ CABERNET 2006 - 2010

2006 KOONUNGA HILL SEVENTY-SIX SHIRAZ CABERNET

Medium-deep crimson. Vibrant dark chocolate, dark cherry, ginger, aniseed aromas and flavours with fine grainy tannins and plenty of mid-palate richness. Finishes chalky firm, long and sweet.

2007 KOONUNGA HILL SEVENTY-SIX SHIRAZ CABERNET

Medium-deep crimson. Dark plum, dark cherry, praline aromas with some leafy notes. Palate is richly concentrated and powerful with sweet dark berry fruit and plush chalky dry tannins. Finishes firm and tight.

2008 KOONUNGA HILL SEVENTY-SIX SHIRAZ CABERNET

Deep crimson. Primary elderberry, dark plum, aniseed, liquorice aromas and flavours. The palate is supple and sweet with superb fruit density and ripe tannins. Finishes hot, firm and long.

2009 KOONUNGA HILL SEVENTY-SIX SHIRAZ CABERNET

Deep crimson to purple. Fragrant red plum. Cherry aromas with some leafy musky notes. A juicy sweet, richly flavoured palate with plummy, red cherry, brambly notes and al dente tannins. Finishes sappy firm and long. Underlying muscular structure with plenty of baby fat.

2010 KOONUNGA HILL AUTUMN RIESLING

Deep inky purple. Intense plush elderberry, musky, liquorice aromas. Very concentrated and powerful with deep-set juicy elderberry, dark plum, liquorice flavours, firm brambly tannins and underlying savoury complexity. Still very elemental but superbly balanced. A wolf in lamb's clothing.
