Shiraz, Cabernet Sauvignon

VINEYARD REGION

South Australia

WINE ANALYSES

Alc/Vol: 14.5%, Acidity 6.5 g/L, pH 3.63

MATURATION

11 months in 13% new American oak and 4% new French oak with the balance in seasoned oak hogsheads.

VINTAGE CONDITIONS

The South Australian vintage will be remembered for producing a small harvest of very high-quality grapes. The growing season was challenging with cool conditions for budburst, very windy conditions for flowering and early summer bushfires in the Adelaide Hills. However, the remainder of the summer and following autumn were very dry with optimal conditions for grapes to ripen. Although yields were down, the overall quality of the harvest was exceptional.

NOSE

Enticing, rich and exotic. First to emerge, red fruits of plum, raspberry and red currants. Summer berry pudding with coulis and crème anglaise. Deliciously spiced with cinnamon, cardamom and vanilla

PALATE

Compote strawberry. Confit duck/duck fat- textural/richness. Mouth coating tannins begin slately and mineral/slightly chewy up front, yet finish velvety/ svelte. The sinewy, chewy and juicy palate provides a lovely line and length. High lifted oak/spice notes. Wellworn leather, wood oven ciabatta crust/ damper. An open weave loose knit palate. A comforting wine in search of generously flavoured food.

Garnet red with crimson edges.
